

**FIRST LANGUAGE GERMAN (Option)**

Examination Board: Cambridge International Examinations (CIE)

Assessment Pattern: Candidates will sit two examinations

Component 1: Reading comprehension and summary writing 2 hours (50%)

Component 2: Writing one creative (narrative or description) and one discursive or argumentative essay 2 hours (50%)

The aims of the syllabus are to:

- enable the students to communicate accurately, appropriately and effectively in writing;
- enable students to understand and respond appropriately to what they read;
- encourage students to enjoy and appreciate the variety of language;
- complement the student's other areas of study by developing skills of a more general application (eg. analysis, synthesis, drawing of inferences);
- promote the students' personal development and an understanding of themselves and others;

Obligatory subjects for Germany

Basic requirements for students who wish to study at university in Germany at a later date:

4 subjects (3 at A level, 1 at AS level) which must include

- 1 Modern Foreign Language, A level German is accepted for German natives as well
- 1 Mathematics OR a Natural Science
- The subject you intend to study
- 1 Option subject
